- Denim must fit and be consistent in color

Unacceptable

Men: shirts with sleeves and if printed, must be in good taste, i.e., not ripped, torn, or tattered

Sportswear: (e.g., golf, tennis, pickleball), men's and women's hats/visors worn with brim facing forward, soft spikes or sports shoes free of dirt

Proper exercise attire and footwear: does not include open midriffs, halter tops, or sports bras without a covering, or women's boy shorts

CAFÉ

Footwear required when in or walking through the Café.

Women: swimwear with cover-up (no thongs) when in or walking through the Café

Men: shirts with sleeves and if printed, must be in good taste, i.e., not ripped, torn, or tattered

Sportswear: (e.g., golf, tennis, pickleball), men's and women's hats/visors worn with brim facing forward, soft spikes or sports shoes free of dirt

Proper exercise attire and footwear: does not include halter tops, or sports bras without a covering, or women's boy shorts
